Oct. 23, 2019 Adams County Ambulance Board Meeting Report

Lifestar reported that there were 1111 reported calls since Jan,1,2019. The Town of Adams has had 74 calls during that time. This accounts for 7% of the total calls. Call numbers are higher this year than the past two years. Saturdays and Mondays continue to be the busiest days. Lifestar representatives indicated that the building their equipment and personnel are presently housed in, will be expanded and remodeled to allow for indoor housing of 3 ambulance units and better accommodations for their employees.

The Board spent a good deal of time reviewing the proposed contract with Lifestar. After discussion, the Board voted to tentavely approve and recommend that each municipality vote to approve said contract for a 5 year term. The Board will have to vote to approve signing the contract and authorize its representative to sign the agreement on behalf of the Town.

The representative from the Town of Springville has indicated they have decided to join the Intergovernmental agreement. The Intergovernmental agreement now represents 8 Towns, The City of Adams, and Village of Friendship, for a total of 11,570 residents.

The next meeting of the Adams County Ambulance Board will be Dec. 4th
