**Type of Work: WEDGE only, Pave both outside edges/lanes of roadway, Location: Deerborn Ave. Commencing at 10<sup>th</sup> Ave going east both sides of the road will be wedged**

Bids are due on, or before: Monday March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 11:00 AM. All bids need to be presented in a sealed envelope to the Town of Adams Highway Crew Director Dick Buhalog at the Town hall. The envelope shall have the project number listed on the front of the envelope and addressed to; "The Town of Adams Chair".

This proposal, submitted by the undersigned bidder to the Town of Adams, is in accordance with the advertised request for proposals. The bidder is to furnish and deliver all materials, and to perform all work for the improvement of the designated project in the time specified, in accordance with the appended Proposal Requirements and Conditions

All bids for public works projects shall be accompanied by a certified check or a bid bond equal to at least 5% of the bid, payable to the Town of Adams, as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted the bidder will execute and file the proper contract and bond within the time established by the Town. If the successful bidder files the contract and bond, upon the execution of the contract by the Town, the check shall be returned. In the event the successful bidder fails to file such contract and bond, the amount of the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the Town as liquidated damages.

## SPECIAL PROVISIONS

**WEDGE only, Pave both outside edges/lanes of roadway: Pave both outside edges/lanes of roadway: Deerborn Ave. Commencing at 10<sup>th</sup> Ave going east both sides of the road will be wedged**

1. Scope of Work: The work under this contract shall consist of wedge paving hot mix asphalt at a thickness of at least 2 inches after compaction and a width of approximately 3+/- feet on the outside edges of both lanes of traffic of Deerborn Ave. The area will be swept, and tack coat applied prior to wedge. Two-foot shoulders will be placed with ¾" CABC rolled and compacted.

2. Hot Mix Asphaltic Pavement: The hot mix shall be Wisconsin DOT approved 4 LT 5828S Mix design or an approved wedge course mix. The contractor shall coordinate with the Town of Adams on an appropriate mix design for the wedge. Mix will be placed with a paver and rolled for compaction. Each driveway shall have a minimum 18" asphalt apron.

3. Preparation: Prior to the application of the bituminous mix, the existing pavement shall be cleaned of all dust, other loose material, silt spots, vegetation and other deleterious materials utilizing a power broom. Any deleterious material not removed by mechanical sweeping shall be removed by hand. Particular care shall be taken to thoroughly clean the outer edges of the area to be wedged. The contractor shall be responsible for the removal of all deleterious material. After cleaning and prior to wedging, a tack coat of a 50% diluted asphalt emulsion type CSS-1, CSS-1h, SS-1 or SS-1h shall be applied to the surface at a nominal rate of 0.025 gallons per square yard.

4. Quantities: All quantities shall be stated in the in the formal bid

5. Completion date shall be September 15, 2026. A penalty shall be imposed of \$500.00 for each day beyond the completion date that the project is completed. The contractor may apply to the Town Board for a waiver of such a penalty if the delay was the result of unexpected, extraordinary weather conditions, or other conditions that were out of the contractor's control.

6. Insurance: No contractor shall commence work under this contract until they have obtained all insurance required under this paragraph.

Performance Bond: The prime contractor shall provide the Town with a payment and performance bond in the amount of contracted price Section 779.14 (1) (s) Wis. Stats. An irrevocable letter of credit may be substituted for payment in lieu of payment and performance bond.

7. Subcontractor: If the contract price exceeds \$30,000 as indexed in Section 779.25 (1) (s) Wis. Stats., the prime contractor agrees, to the extent practicable, to maintain a list of all subcontractors, suppliers and service providers performing, furnish or procuring labor, services, materials, plans, or specification under the contract. (Sec. 779.14 (1e)(b) Wis. Stats.)

The Town of Adams may make direct payment to subcontractors or may pay the prime contractor with checks that are payable to the prime contractor and to one or more subcontractor Section 779.14 (1m) (d) Wis. Stats.).

8. Liability: The prime contractor shall be solely responsible for all liability associated with the contractor's performance of the project. The prime contractor agrees to indemnify the Town of Adams for any liability that may be imputed to the Town associated with the prime contractor's performance of the project.

Other requirements: By submitting a bid for this project, the prime contractor agrees to do the following:

- a. Pay all claims for labor, service, materials, plans, or specifications performed, furnished, procured, used, or consumed that pertain to the public work Section 779.14 (1e) (a) Wis. Stats.)
- b. Comply with all requirements of any applicable federal and state regulations.
- c. Perform work on the project in a safe, good and workmanlike manner.
