

ROAD WORK PROPOSAL #6

West 7th Dr. project

Dig out sunken holes in the road as marked. Remove any debris such as tree stumps etc. Back fill with sand compact and place 6 inches of compacted gravel upon the sand and grade level with the remaining road surface.

The bid shall include, removal of all debris, trucking costs, and all materials needed to complete the project. The project needs to be started after April 10th, 2026 and finished on or before Sept. 1 2026

This proposal, submitted by the undersigned bidder to the Town of Adams, is in accordance with the advertised request for proposals. The bidder is to furnish and deliver all materials, and to perform all work for the improvement of the designated project in the time specified, in accordance with the appended Proposal Requirements and Conditions.

Bids are due on, or before: Monday March 9th, 2026 at 11:00 AM. All bids need to be presented in a sealed envelope to the Town of Adams Highway Crew Director Dick Buhalog at the Town hall. The envelope shall have the project number listed on the front of the envelope and addressed to; "The Town of Adams Chair. Each project shall be placed in a separate sealed envelope

Liability: The prime contractor shall be solely responsible for all liability associated with the contractor's performance of the project. The prime contractor agrees to indemnify the Town of Adams for any liability that may be imputed to the Town associated with the prime contractor's performance of the project.

The Town High crew foreman or the Town Chair shall be notified at least 24 hours before work on the project is started

Other requirements:

By submitting a bid for this project, the prime contractor agrees to do the following:

- a. Pay all claims for labor, service, materials, plans, or specifications performed, furnished, procured, used, or consumed that pertain to the public work Section 779.14 (le) (a) Wis. Stats.)
- b. Comply with all requirements of any applicable federal and state regulations.
- c. Perform work on the project in a safe, good and workmanlike manner. Comply with any and all applicable federal and state regulations.

The Town of Adams understands this may be a difficult project to bid, but would like an idea as to cost associated with these repairs, so a time and material bid with estimated time/hour rate costs for equipment and labor, plus an estimate of material costs would

be in order. An estimate with "not to exceed" limit would/may be considered by the Board.
